“Although aircrafts are designed and certificated to withstand flight in severe turbulence and pilots are trained to cope with many situations - through a deep recurrent training and aircraft’s onboard technology - , it is important, therefore, for aircraft occupants to have their seatbelts fastened while seated should any unexpected encounters occur and follow immediately crew instruction to reduce any potential injury event.
